### Dear Friends

# Jennie writes on remembering .....

My Mother was chatting to a salesman in her front room. I joined in the conversation which soon left the product on sale to;- 'Where do you come from?' 'Bet you've never heard of it,' says I. 'It's Burham, a village upstream from Rochester'. 'Heard of it' says he, 'I was brought up in Wouldham. Lived opposite the church. Never attended but went there for the school harvest and on Trafalgar Day. Do they still put flowers on that fellow's tomb? Well I never! Was a great place to be a lad in. Me and my pals would go down the chalk pits first thing and our Mums never saw us again till supper time. Does the High Street still get jammed up? I remember the village discussions about a back-road through the allotments. Nothing came of it. Do you know .....?' And yes, several are still familiar surnames in the village these three decades later.

That's joyful remembering, and perhaps village communities particularly encourage such 'remembering' because they are 'people-sized'. Just as you can be a valued member of a choir or the football team or the WI, because they are people-sized so you can be a valued member of a people-sized village. I guess it's not the same in suburbia or a town. In suburbia you may become a 'prominent resident' and in a town perhaps a 'valued citizen', but the majority possibly remain anonymous householders. Here though, in the villages, we can all be that special thing 'a member', which is very like the different members of our own bodies; legs and arms, hearts and eyes. Those, when joined in good health and activity can become something that is very much alive and kicking with its own character.

This 'remembering', it can be done in two ways. The salesman remembered in a nostalgic way, going back in his mind to the folk and events of his childhood. It didn't change anything today. Alternatively we can let the past trigger our present actions as 'village members', living and working together today to create communities buzzing with neighbourliness and active in support of our two schools, parish councils, churches, shops, pubs and organizations catering for tiny-ones to the most senior.

On November 13th, when we gather around the War Memorials at Burham and Wouldham to hear again the names of those who sacrificed their lives for us in two World Wars, is it not this second active type of remembering that most honours them? At each fortnightly service of Holy Communion in All Saints the congregation pledges itself before God to 'pursue all that makes for peace and builds up our common life'. Surely that's what God desires of us?

#### WOULDHAM PARISH COUNCIL

At the last Parish Council Meeting, on 5<sup>th</sup> October, PCSO Julie Stoner reported on 2 thefts in the last month in Wouldham. The first was the theft of a caravan from the recreation ground car park and the second was the theft of a manhole cover in the village.

Local Community Warden, Dave Leipnik, updated us further on the 'Love where you live' Tonbridge & Malling Campaign. This will start in Wouldham with a litter pick up on Wouldham Common on 7<sup>th</sup> November. He will also meet with Jill Harris from Valley of Visions to work alongside Wouldham School on a project called 'Back to the future', starting in November. This will look at the past, present and future of Wouldham. In June 2012, the Queen's Diamond Jubilee will take place. Her Majesty the Queen will become only the second Monarch in British history to celebrate 60 years on the throne (the previous Monarch being Queen Victoria). Have you got any ideas on how you would like to mark this historic event in Wouldham? The Parish Council would like to hear from residents with their ideas and suggestions so please email the Parish Clerk.

#### BURHAM PARISH COUNCIL NEWS

Skate ramp MK II Phase 1: All being well, work has now been completed. The official opening has been booked for Saturday 12 November 2011 at 11.00am. The Mayor will be in attendance (see flyer opposite).

Rubicon, Europe's biggest and most active provider for skate board lessons will also be there for some extra fun, learner sessions and product "give-aways." Teaching/training sessions for skate boarders and BMX riders have been booked with Rubicon for Spring/Summer next year. Obviously I'll keep you updated nearer the time.

Speed Indictor Devices (SID's): As you are aware, the Parish Council has been trying their best to have some SID's installed in the village for several years. Finally, this is looking more positive. We are awaiting location plans and costs from KHS and it is hoped that the project could be funded from a pot of money via County Councillor Homewood for highway projects. As always, we will keep you posted.

Public Car Parks: As a reminder, if you are using any of the public car parks within the village (ie Village Hall, Bell Lane, and Church Street), your vehicle must have appropriate MOT, insurance and road tax. Recently, there have been some vehicles that have not been showing up to date road tax. Obviously with parking at a premium within the village, this is unfair to other users.

Recycling (in particular paper and cardboard): Keep up the good work! So far, since April you, the residents have raised over £1000 by recycling your waste cardboard and paper. Well done. Any funding raised in this manner, is spent on additional community projects over and above those normally addressed by the Parish Council.

# Winter Fuel Grant 2011

Applications for grants towards the costs of winter fuel bills are invited from residents of the Ancient Parish of Burham.

To qualify for assistance applicants should be aged 65 years or over and have lived within the boundaries of the Ancient Parish for the past 10 years.

The weekly HOUSEHOLD income of applicants, i.e. the total income from all occupants, must not exceed £225 for single occupancy or £285 for multiple occupancy. For this purpose, income is determined after deducting half of rent payable (rent after deducting any housing benefit received) and ignoring attendance allowance and similar state benefits and credits. Only one application per household will be considered. The Trustees reserve the right to make such enquiries as they believe necessary to confirm entitlement to the grant.

# BURHAM CHURCH OF ENGLAND PRIMARY SCHOOL



Welcome to Burham CE Primary School's news item. We are proud to inform you of our achievements during the last academic year:

- Our Foundation Stage Profile (where Reception age children are assessed for their Personal Social Emotional Development and Communication Language and Literacy) was 5% above the Kent average. This is the best outcome for Burham in the last 3 years.
- Our end of Key Stage 1 key indicator of level 2B+ results showed the best outcomes for the last 3 years at 76.5% Reading, 70.6% Writing and 82.3% Maths. The improvement in writing is up 13% on 2010 and 30% on 2009.
- Our more able pupils at the end of Key Stage 1 had the best three year consistency between maths, writing and reading level 3+ which is broadly inline with the Kent average.
- Our pupil progress at the end of end of Key Stage 2 was above national average for making 2 levels progress with 84.6% at level 4+ in English and 92.3% at level 4+ in Maths.
- Our more able pupils at the end of Key Stage 2 percentage for level 5 was broadly in line with the national average.

We should like to say well done to all our pupils (present and past) for their excellent achievements and working so hard plus thank all our teaching and support staff whose hard work and commitment have helped the school to attain such brilliant results. Last, but by no means least, we should like to say a huge thank you to all our parents for supporting the school and their child (ren) with homework.

Children at the school not only work hard but they play hard too and have the opportunity to attend a diverse selection of clubs run either during lunchtime or after school such as:

Kingsquad, Construction, Yoga, Singing and Dancing, Film, Knitting, Kwik Cricket, Football and Netball.

We also run a Breakfast Club from 7:45a.m. - 8:45a.m. which is open to all our children, costs only £2 for an hour's care and a healthy breakfast. During our Breakfast Club children have lots of fun playing games, making things, doing puzzles, playing table tennis etc.


